Julia Schäfer: Writing Station

The Writing Station was an efficiently arranged space at the entrance of the GfZK. From this station, it was possible to send postcards from a series produced by Iris Reuther. The series included images from Leipzig, which would not normally be considered tourist images or seen on picture postcards (for example: empty apartments, apartment ruins, a small private zoo, an empty swimming pool,...). The cashier's desk provided postage, and a mailbox was available at the station. Visitors were asked to mark the destination of their postcards by placing a pushpin on a large world map provided at the station. The entire effort ended after two years, at which time, I wrote a few of the recipients and requested that they send me atypical images of their regions. These responses were then collected and presented together with the writing station in the exhibition \rightarrow The Picture Postcard \leftarrow .
